MIAMI

houses the largest private contemporary art collection in the United States, and Superblue (2021), which presents digital and immersive works of art.

This small district borders Wynwood and it was influenced by its earliest residents who immigrated from Cuba, Central America and Dominican Republic. The neighbourhood boasts a range of popular restaurants, such as Papo Llega y Pon and Laguna Seafood Restaurant. Art has propelled the neighborhood to evolve into the popular destination it is today.


BUENOS AIRES


